The Gateway to the San Juan National Forest

Combine a great bridge weekend with discovering Durango's appeal. There is spectacular scenery in the San Juan National Forest with eight mountain peaks rising to elevations of more than 14,000 feet within 40 miles of Durango. Fly fishing is very popular and trout are plentiful in the area. The best narrow gauge railroad ride in the nation originates in Durango, proceeds through the rugged beauty of the San Juans and terminates in the historic mining town of Silverton, Colorado. Mesa Verde National Park lies 40 miles west of town and other Anasazi ruins are nearby. The Durango area also boasts three scenic and challenging golf courses. World-class restaurants abound in our small town, so check out the List.

The June weather in Durango is excellent. High temperatures average 87° F with lows averaging 53° F. The average rainfall for the month of June is only 0.68 inches.

How to Get to the Tournament Site

Take Main Avenue north from downtown to 24th Street. Turn east (right) onto 24th Street toward Durango High School. Take the first left (to the north) to the Senior Center.
